





ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

STUDENT

- 1.Be between the ages of 15–18 (by first day of employment)
- 2. Have never been apart of the DRPS Youth in Policing Initiative
- 3. Reside in the Regional Municipality of Durham
- 4. Currently enrolled in secondary school
- 5.Be returning to secondary school in September 2025
- 6. Legally eligible to work in Canada
- 7. Must not have any family members employed by a Police Service in Ontario*

TEAM LEADER

- 1.Be a graduate of the Durham Regional Police Service's Youth in Policing Initiative
- 2. Reside in the Regional Municipality of Durham
- 3. Currently enrolled in secondary school or postsecondary school
- 4.Be returning to secondary school or post secondary school in September 2025
- 5. Legally eligible to work in Canada
