COURSE SELECTION

From your **Dashboard**, click on the **Plan Courses** button that appears in the High School Progress box. The button will say **Plan Courses** if course submission has not yet been enabled at your school.

Note:

French Immersion Programming includes French Immersion (FIF1DF), Canadian Geography (CGC1WF), Integrated Arts (ALC1OF) OR Instrumental Music (AMI1OF) and Healthy Active Living (PPL1OF). Students wishing to earn a DDSB French Immersion Certificate must complete 10 French Immersion credits, including all FIF courses. Students taking FIF1DF **MUST** also take CGC1DF, ALC1OF or AMI1OF and PPL1OF. See French Immersion folder for course offerings and information in mBp.

Gifted Programming is offered in Canadian Geography (CGC1WG), English (ENL1WG), Math (MTH1WG), Science (SNC1WG). Students must select CGC1W1, ENL1W1, MTH1W1, and SNC1W1. Students will be reviewed into the Gifted Program during the IPRC meeting with our Inclusive Student Services Department. These courses are view only. Students wishing to earn the DDSB Gifted Certificate must be identified with Giftedness and complete 8 credits with at least one at the senior level.

ADD COURSES

- In High School Planner, click + **[Course]** (ie) + English
- In the **Course Selection and Details** screen, explore the available courses
- Click **Add Course** when you find the course you want.

HINT: You can filter by Grade and by Discipline.

Note: For students in the French Immersion program, there is a Discipline titled, “French Immersion”

You must select 8 courses total. When selecting elective courses, please place them in order of preference. You must also select the equivalent of two (2) alternate courses.

REVIEW COURSES

When you are ready to submit your course selections, click the blue **Review Course Selections** button and give your course selection one final look over.
