Honouring Identities

- In today's PPHS Honouring Identities segment, we recognize the Jewish holiday of Passover. During Passover, Jewish people remember their time in the desert and reflect on the journey from oppression to freedom. The eating of unleavened bread – called Matzah – serves as a powerful symbol of both the hardships faced and the strength and resilience of those who came before.
- Today we also recognize the sacred observance of Easter within the Christian faith. This holy time begins with Good Friday, a day that commemorates the crucifixion of Jesus Christ and invites reflection on sacrifice, suffering, and love. It leads into Easter Sunday, which celebrates the resurrection – an event at the heart of Christian belief, symbolizing hope, renewal, and the promise of new life. For many, Easter Monday continues this time of reflection, connection, and community. For our Christian students, staff, and families, Easter holds deep spiritual meaning.
