- Yesterday marked the first day of Advent, a period observed in many Christian traditions as a time of reflection, hope, and preparation leading up to Christmas. During Advent, individuals and families may light candles, engage in acts of kindness, or participate in community gatherings that focus on peace and anticipation. If Advent is part of your family's traditions, we wish you a peaceful and thoughtful season.
- And today, December 2, is the International Day for the Abolition of Slavery, a day that raises awareness about modern forms of exploitation, including human trafficking, forced labour, and child labour. The White Ribbon Campaign
