- In today's Honouring Identities Segment, we recognize **Pink Shirt Day** – a movement that began in Nova Scotia when two students, **Travis Price** and **David Shepherd**, took action after witnessing a Grade 9 student experience homophobic bullying for wearing a pink shirt. What started as a simple act of solidarity grew into a national movement to raise awareness and stand against bullying. While Pink Shirt Day reminds us to address bullying in all its forms, it also invites us to reflect on the roots bullying often has in **homophobia, transphobia, and harmful gender stereotypes**. These attitudes can limit people's ability to live freely, safely, and authentically. Today, we honour the importance of creating spaces where everyone is respected for who they are and how they express themselves.
