Treaties Recognition Week at Port Perry High School

- In today's "Treaties Recognition Week Teachable Moment" we pause to honour the living legacy of the Williams Treaties and the people of the Mississaugas of Scugog Island First Nation whose presence enriches our school community.
- Did you know that just seven years ago, in 2018, the Williams Treaties First Nations and the governments of Canada and Ontario finalized the Williams Treaties Settlement Agreement? This historic agreement formally recognized and reaffirmed the constitutionally protected rights to hunt, fish, trap, and gather for food, social, and ceremonial purposes following official recognition that the governments failed to honour, and legally breached, the original Treaties.
- Today's Treaty Week "Self-Think" question is: How can understanding treaty history help us ensure that past injustices are not repeated in our generation and the ones still to come?
